### *Unicoi State Park and Lodge*

In the midst of the Chattahoochee National Forest, located just two miles from the Alpine Village of Helen, the lodge and park are beautiful settings for group meetings, family gatherings, and conferences. #### *The Teachers*

**Scott Reid** was born and raised in Hamilton, Ontario. He and his family moved to Burlington where he taught a variety of technical subjects at the high school level. Scott is now retired and living in Dundas, Ontario, Canada with his wife, Catherine.

Scott received his Prelim in 2009 and his Full Teaching Certificate in 2011. For the past few years, he has enjoyed teaching SCD in Hamilton at all levels and is presently teaching a level 2 Technique Class. Scott was a featured teacher at several Canadian workshops and a guest teacher at Thistle School in North Carolina. Scott is a past Chairman of RSCDS Hamilton Branch and remains very involved in the running of SCD events for his Branch.

**Catherine (Cate) Reid** was born in Kirkcaldy, Fife, Scotland and immigrated to Canada at the age of five. Although retired for the past several years, she had a rewarding career as an elementary teacher.

Catherine started dancing in her teens with June Shore and had a long break from it before returning later in life. She received her Prelim in 2009 and her Full Teaching Certificate in 2011. Catherine has taught every level of Scottish Country Dance with the Hamilton, Ontario Branch and currently co-teaches a Level 1 class. Catherine has taught classes and workshops in Ontario, Detroit, and at Thistle School in North Carolina. She has been coordinator of the Hamilton Demonstration Team for the past seven years.

#### *Our Musicians*

Violist **Elke Baker** (<http://elkebaker.com/>), a U.S. National Scottish Fiddle Champion, has played all over North America and in places as far flung as Japan, West Africa, and Scotland. Elke is a faculty member at the Washington Conservatory of Music where she teaches history and performance of Celtic music. She brings a scholar's depth of knowledge and an extremely engaging manner to her performances, as well as an intimate knowledge of just what makes people want to dance.

She plays contra, Scottish, historic, English, Irish and Klezmer music on piano, harp and fiddle. Julie teaches Suzuki piano students and master classes, judges Piano Guild auditions nationally, and holds posts at the Raleigh Piano Teachers Association. She enjoys working folk music styles into her classical piano students' musical education.
