

Mount Pinatubo (R8x32) 3C (4C Set)

- 1-8 1C, 2C, and 3C set. 3C dance a half figure of eight around 2C, crossing up to begin. 3C cross RH back to place.
- 9-16 1C, 2C and 3C set. 1C and 3C cross by RH. 2C and 3C dance a double half figure of eight, 2C cross down to begin (3C should end in own place, 1C and 2C are on opposite sides).
- 17-24 All three couples dance Inveran reel of three on the sides (1C and 2C will end on opposite sides).
- 25-32 1C followed by 2C cross RH and cast behind the line as far as the lava flows (in 4 bars), then cast back and return with 2C leading up to first place and 1C ending in second place. Repeat. On second time through, 3C (in fourth position) will step up on bars 31-32 and 1C will finish at the bottom of the set.

Mount Pinatubo was a volcano that erupted in the Philippines in 1991. The effects were felt worldwide. Though devastating at the time, today Mount Pinatubo has a new lake, rivers, and canyons. Plant and animal life are returning to the once ash-covered lands.
